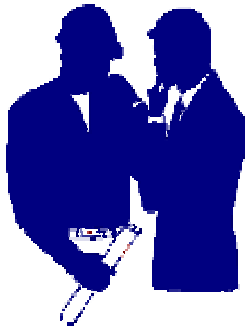


Why come to this workshop?
